Suggested Itinerary





DAY 1

Arrive at Split Airport. Meet & greet at the airport and transfer by coach to the hotel in the city centre. Check in, dinner and overnight at the hotel.



DAY 2

After breakfast, drive to the city of Trogir, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. En route, stop at the Kastel Luksic to visit a small botanical garden belonging to the local elementary school and run by the children and their teachers. The garden boasts over 1000 plant species and it is protected as a park architecture monument. In Trogir, enjoy a walking tour of the medieval city. A lunch will be served in a local restaurant.







On our return, stop in Split, visit the Marjan Park Forest on the Marjan hill, covered in a dense Mediterranean pine forest and completely surrounded by the city and the sea, making it a unique sight. Used as a park by the citizens as early as the 3rd century, now it is a favourite weekend excursion destination and a recreational centre. It is also the setting for numerous beaches and jogging trails as well as tennis courts, all surrounded by the scenic forest, offering a view of the entire city, the surrounding islands, and the nearby mountains. The tip of the peninsula houses the Institute of Oceanography and Fisheries. A guided tour of Split follows a visit to the Park and the Botanic garden of the Faculty of Science.







Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Split.

DAY 3

After breakfast, drive along the coastal highway towards a city of Makarska to visit Kotisina botanic garden located on the coastal slopes of the Biokovo mountain, at an altitude of 350-500 meters. The garden was founded by a Franciscan priest and scholar with the purpose of scientific research, monitoring, protection, conservation, and popularization of the local flora. In the city of Makarska, visit the Malacological Museum – a rich collection of sea shells, followed by a lunch in a local restaurant.







After lunch, drive though the Mount Biokovo Tunnel to visit the town of Imotski in the Dalmatian hinterland. Imotski is known for its medieval fortress on the rocks of Blue Lake. Another phenomenon is the Red Lake which looks like an eye in the scenery. Both lakes are a karst phenomenon attracting visitors from all over the world. Return to Split via town of Trilj, located on the Cetina River. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Split.









DAY 4

Following breakfast at the hotel in Split, drive towards the Krka River National Park which is located along the middle-lower course of the Krka River in central Dalmatia. It is a spacious, largely unchanged region of exceptional and multifaceted natural value, and includes one or more preserved or insignificantly altered ecosystems. The Krka Waterfalls Park has a high concentration of pollen attracting wasps and bees in the area. After the tour of the Park, a lunch will be served in a local restaurant.







Enjoy free time for your own explore or rest in beautiful natural surroundings. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5

Transfer from the hotel to Split Airport for your flight home.
